HIGH SCHOOL JUNE SCHOLARSHIP BRACKET CHALLENGE

FORMAT & ELIGIBILITY

Bowl 3 games per squad. Two squads to try to qualify for bracket.

Bowl three game qualifier on same pair of lanes. You can enter both squads.

You can only qualify once for the bracket at each event.

Scratch bowling. No handicap. Separate Boys & Girls division.

Top eight boys and eight girls from each squad will advance to the bracket finals.

Bracket will be a single elimination sixteen person bracket. Separate bracket for boys and girls.

Must be USBC Youth Sanctioned.

To be eligible to bowl, you must meet one of the following criteria.

- Currently attending a Kansas Public, Private High School, or equivalent Home School program.
- Graduated from a Kansas Public, Private High School, or equivalent Home School program in May of 2026.
- Entering the fall 2026 semester as a freshman to a Kansas Public, Private High School, or equivalent Home School program.

Added Prize Money \$3,000 per division

Prize fund payout based on minimum of 30 Entries for Division

**1st Place: \$1,600 2nd Place: \$800 3rd & 4th Place: \$400 5th - 8th Place \$225
9th - 16th Place: \$125 TOTAL = \$5,100**

INFORMATION

1. This tournament is certified and governed by all USBC Rules & Regulations.
2. This tournament is open to student athletes who are currently attending a Public, Private Kansas High School, or Home School equivalent program, and are USBC Youth sanctioned. A school I.D. or other proof of attendance will be required to participate in tournament.
3. **June Tournament Only:** Can participate if you graduated from a Public, Private Kansas High School, or Home School equivalent in May of 2026. Can participate if you are entering the fall 2026 semester as a freshman to a Kansas Public, Private, or Home School equivalent program.
4. This is a scratch event. No handicap.
5. There will be a separate division for boys and girls. Payout is based on the entries for that division.
6. Multiple entries are allowed. You can only qualify once for the bracket for each tournament.
7. Entry fee is **\$100** per person, per squad. Squads are 10 AM & 1 PM. Announcements and practice will start at 9:45 AM & 12:45 PM respectively.
8. Check-in time will begin one hour before each squad.
9. Entry Fee Break down: \$30 Lineage, \$70 prize fund. \$3,000 per division is added from expiring SMART Funds.
10. Any entrant that is late will be allowed to start bowling as long as 5 frames of the 1st game of qualifying has not been completed. If they arrive later than what is stated above, they will be disqualified from the tournament. No refund will be given.
11. **Deadline for entering the tournament is the day before, no later than 10 PM.**
12. This tournament will follow USBC Rule 301b. Bowlers are not allowed to wear hats, play arcade games, use tobacco products, use foul language or gestures. They cannot wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, or an illegal substance. Bowlers violating this rule will be given one warning and then will be removed from the tournament & bowling center.
13. Results will be posted on the center's website and Facebook.
14. All entries will be processed through the center's reservation system. No checks or cash allowed.
15. If the 1 PM squad does not fill up, 10 AM entrants may re-enter at that time by paying with a credit card or cash. No checks will be accepted.

ADDENDUM

Qualifying for the 16 person bracket:

- 1) If you bowl the 10 AM or 1 PM squad and place in the top 8 of your division in that squad, you will be seeded into the bracket with that score.
- 2) If you qualify from the 10 AM squad and decide to bowl in the 1 PM squad the following rules apply:
 - A) If your 1 PM score places you in the top eight of that squad and results in a higher seeding in the bracket, we will use that score.
 - B) If your 1 PM score does not place you in the top eight of that squad, the 1 PM score will not be used.
 - C) If your 1 PM score places you in the top eight of that squad, but do not result in a higher seeding in the bracket, we will not use that score.
- 3) If your score from the 10 AM squad is not in the top eight, you have two options.
 - A) You can choose not bowl the 1 PM squad.
 1. If someone else bowls both squads and their 1 PM scores move them up in the bracket from their morning scores, then we will move the next person up the finish list from the 10 AM squad.
 - B) You can bowl the 1 PM squad and try to improve your finish position.

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
