2025 KSBPA State Mixed Rules

- 1 All participants must be members of the USBC and must present current membership card. Should the participant not hold a current USBC card, they can be purchased on-site at the tournament for \$35. All entrants must be 18 years of age as of 10/31/2025. Gender is based on current government issued ID.
- 2 \$500 Guaranteed first place team in each division, based on a minimum of 20 team entries
- 3 The 2025 KSBPA State Mixed Tournament shall include competition in 4-person mixed teams in one of the 2 divisions, Division 1 2 men & 2 women per team. Division 2 any mix must have one person of the opposit sex present on a 4 person team. Doubles in 2 divisions, division 1 Mixed doubles (1 man & 1 woman), Division 2 Same sex doubles. Singles and Handicap and Scratch All-events will be separated into a men's division and a women's division. Bowlers entering Doubles must enter singles and vise versa. Paid All-Events are non-transferable, unless the substitute is replacing the original bowler in all three events and the transfer is made prior to the bowler competing in any event.
- 4 Handicap is to be based on 90% of 220.
- 5 All bowlers shall submit their highest certified average based on a minimum of 21 games as follows:
 - a. Highest 2024-2025 book average (NO SPORT LEAGUE AVERAGES WILL BE ALLOWED)
 - b. If no book average, use highest certified league average of 21 games or more as of November 1, 2025. Please submit league standing sheet at time of check in.
 - c. Bowlers with no average will enter scratch.
 - d. IT SHALL BE THE RESONSIBILITY OF EACH BOWLER TO VERIFY ACCURACY OF THEIR AVERAGE.
 FAILURE TO USE PROPER AVERAGE OR MAKE CORRECTIONS PRIOR TO THE START OF
 COMPETITION TOURAMENT SHALL DISQUALIFY THE SCORES IF THE SUBMITTED AVERAGE IS
 LOWER THEN THE ACTUAL AVERAGE.
 - e. TOURNAMENT MANAGER HAS THE RIGHT TO RERATE ANYONE AT ANY TIME.
- 7 10 PIN RULE USBC RULE 319a-2 will be in effect. If at the time of bowling an entrant has a current average (21 or more games) which is 10 pins or more higher than the entering average, the current higher average must be used.
- 8 All Team Captains are responsible for checking their team roster. Please enter all entrants' first and last name; do not list nicknames. Teams and Doubles will bowl in the order they are entered on the entry blank. There will be NO order changing once the entry blank has been submitted.
 Substitutes will bowl in the position of the person they are replacing
- 9 Teams wishing to bowl together must submit entry forms together

- 10 All entry fees must be paid in-full and must accompany the entry blank. *Make remittances* payable to: Flint Hills Lanes. No entry fees will be refunded.
- 11 Entry fee is \$30 per bowler per event (team, doubles & singles, \$5 Handicap All-events & \$10 Scratch All-Events. Breakdown of linage, administrative fee and prize fund located on front of entry form.
- 12 **MULTIPLE ENTRIES**: Bowlers may enter the Team Event twice, providing that not more than two members of the original team bowl on the second entry. All-Events will be based on the first team event bowled. Bowlers may enter Singles and Doubles event twice cashing in the top 10 only once.
- 13 **PENALTIES:** Tardy players will start in the frame being bowled, with zero being given for each frame missed. Use of an ineligible player or reporting and incorrect average will nullify all claims for any prize or award.
- 14 It is the players responsibility to record their scores on the tournament recap sheet. Bowlers must verify that the score recorded matches the score bowled. Bowlers must sign recap sheet verifying scores are accurate and complete
- 15 Scoring corrections must be made at the time the error occurs. Tournament officials or assistants will make all scoring corrections.
- 16 Protests of errors in scoring or calculations must be made in writing to the Tournament Management within 24 hours after bowling or the scores will stand.
- 17 Prize checks will be mailed to the team captain at the address provided. All prize checks must be cashed within 90 days of the check being written.
- 18 In the event of mechanical failure, it is hereby agreed that the contestants effected shall be moved to the next available pair of lanes.
- 19 All rules not covered will refer back to the USBC RULES book. Any protest of any kind must be made in writing within 24 hours to the tournament manager.
- 20 Check in will begin 1 hour before each squad. Please be checked in at least 30 minutes prior to your squad time. If time allows we may start any squad early.



Event practice time will begin 10 minutes prior to the squad start time.
