## **Format and Rules**

- 1. All Bowlers will bowl 4 games of qualifying.
- 2. 1:4 entries from each squad will advance to the finals
- 3. Bowlers will use their highest verifiable average from the 2024-2025 bowling season. If no average exists, bowlers will be allowed to use their highest current average (min 21 games). If neither average exists, bowlers will use their most recent average that is posted on bowl.com or an average will be determined by the tournament director based on past or present performance.
- 4. If there is a tie for the last qualifying spot in a squad, both players will advance
- 5. The first round of the finals, everyone will bowl 2 games. The top 50% of the field will advance to the next round. All players that advance will then bowl 1 game elimination rounds until the field is down to 4 bowlers. Those 4 bowlers will then bowl 1 game and the highest score (with handicap) will be the winner.
- 6. Any ties in the finals will broken by a 1 ball, sudden death roll-off with the higher qualifying score starting the tiebreaker.
- 7. USBC Youth bowlers will be allowed to participate provided they sign the rule 400 waiver. All monies won by any youth will be deposited into their USBC SMART Account.
- 8. Bowlers are asked to arrive at least 30 minutes prior to squad time. Any bowler arriving late may be allowed to bowl but must take a zero for every frame that is missed provided there is space available
- 9. Prize Money returned 100%
- 10. Any rule that is not listed here will fall under USBC guidelines.
- 11. Bowling Ball Surface Change during qualifying will be allowed up until the first ball of competition is thrown. No other surface changes will be allowed during qualifying.
- 12. The tournament director has the final ruling on all disputes, tournament format, and prize fund.
- 13. Lanes will be oiled before the 11AM Squad ONLY.
